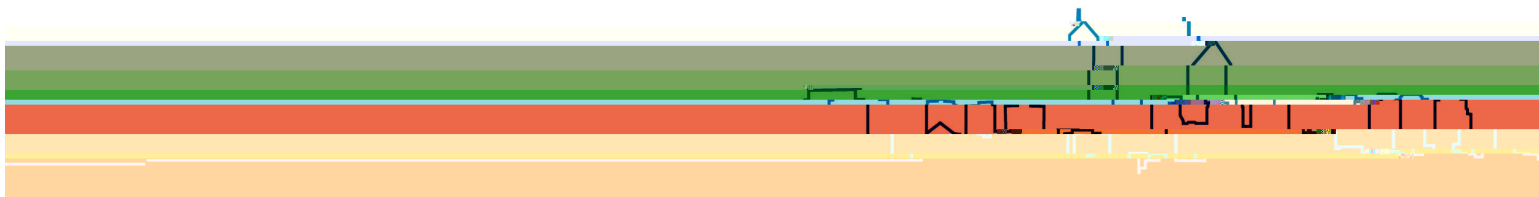




## 1. . **The Proposal and the Wholesale Market Objectives**

Griffin Energy submits that the proposed changes would address the Wholesale Market Objectives and

a) *to promote the economically efficient, safe and*





- a) to promote the economically efficient safe and reliable production and supply of electricity and electricity related services in the South West interconnected system
- b) to encourage competition among generators and retailers in the South West interconnected system including facilitating efficient entry of new competitors
- c) to avoid discrimination in that it does not favour any particular energy options and technologies including sustainable energy options and technologies such as those that promote the use of renewable resources or that reduce overall greenhouse gas emissions
- d) to minimise the long term cost of electricity supplied to customers from the South West interconnected system and
- e) to encourage the taking of measures to manage the amount of electricity used and when it is used
