Cape Farquhar Sanctuary Area

Gnarraloo Bay Sanctuary Area

All waters bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the high water along the meridian to the intersection with thence southerly along the meridian to the intersection with the high water mark on the coastline; thence generally north westerly then south westerly along the high water mark on the coastline to the commencement point.
