

x The Reserve Capacity Mechanism (RCM) Review is considering (among other things) the methodology for setting the BRCP.<sup>4</sup> The RCM Review is expected to be completed in mid-2023, and the Minister for Energy is expected to subsequently make rule changes to give effect to the outcomes of the review.

Therefore, the Coordinator has extended the timeframe for publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for RC\_2014\_05 until 30 June 2023 to allow adequate time for the completion of the RCM Review.

- x The Coordinator completes the MPM Review.
- x The Coordinator completes the RCM Review.
- x The Coordinator presents its draft decision in a Draft Rule Change Report.
- x The second submission period takes place.
- x The Coordinator presents its final decision in a Final Rule Change Report.
- x If the Coordinator's decision is to approve Amending Rules that affect Protected Provisions, the Minister considers the Rule Change Proposal and makes a decision regarding the proposed Amending Rules.
- x If approved, any Amending Rules commence.
