



Which workers are eligible for MyLeave?

Only workers working on-site in classifications of work listed in a prescribed award are eligible for MyLeave. Workers employed in an employer's own workshop or yard, and administration, clerical and managerial workers are not eligible for MyLeave. Left the industry? No longer eligible? No longer accumulating service days? What happens to my accumulated service days?

Our legislation defines 1 year of service as 220 service days, in an eligible job role in the Construction Industry.

1 year of employment is not necessarily considered to be 1 year of service.

220 service days in an eligible job role in the Construction Industry

Where 1/2 year of service is accumulated

Where 1/2 year of service is accumulated, the employee is eligible for MyLeave. If the employee has accumulated 1/2 year of service, they will be eligible for MyLeave. For Working Directors, the 'ordinary rate of pay' is the rate of pay being received by Directors as workers of their firm. This would be the amount that they receive as wages on a defined, regular, at least monthly basis, that they pay tax on a Pay As You Go (PAYG) basis, have wage records
