I, HYWEL DAVID EVANS, Minister for Fisheries, hereby give notice pursuant to sections 9 and section 11 of the Fisheries Act 1905 that -

- (a) The taking of fish by means of nets in the waters specified in Column 1 of the Schedule is prohibited at all times other than the times specified in relation thereto in Column 2 of the Schedule; bST(905)
- (b) The species listed in Column 3 of the Schedule may be taken at the times shown in those waters by the means specified in relation thereto in Column 4 of the Schedule.
- (c) The notice published in the *Government Gazette* dated 10 May 1985 relating to those portions of Western Australian waters specified in the Schedule below is hereby cancelled.
