FISHERIES ACT 1905  
Prohibition on the Use of Pointed Instruments Notice 1991  
Notice No. 469

97/54.

Made by the Minister under sections 9, 10 and 11.

**Citation**

1. This notice may be cited as the *Prohibition on the Use of Pointed Instruments Notice 1991*.

**Prohibition on taking fish**

2. All persons are prohibited from taking any fish whatsoever by means of spearguns, harpoons, Hawaiian slings, and all other pointed instruments in waters specified in the first schedule excepting that the species listed in the second schedule may be taken by means of handspears.

**Revocation**

3. The notice dated 28 October 1969 and published in the *Gazette* on 31 October 1969 is cancelled.

FIRST SCHEDULE

All rivers, streams, brooks, together with their tributaries and effluents and dams within Western Australia.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Estuarine Cobbler (*Cnidoglanis macrocephalus*).
