FISHERIES ACT 1905
TRAWLING PROHIBITION (WHOLE OF STATE) NOTICE 1992

Notice No. 556

Made by the Minister under sections 9, 10 and 11.

Citation

1. This notice shall be cited as the *Trawling Prohibition (Whole of State) Notice 1992*.

Commencement

2. This notice shall come into effect on 1 January 1993.

Prohibition on trawling

3. Subject to Clause 4, I hereby prohibit all persons from taking, or attempting to take, fish by means of a trawl net in the waters described in the Schedule.

Application of notice

4. The provisions of this notice shall apply to all persons other than -
- (1) licensed professional fishermen using a licensed fishing boat which is -
 - (a) being operated in a limited entry fishery declared by notice under section 32;
 - (b) authorised to be operated in that limited entry fishery; and
 - (c) being operated in accordance with the specifications published in the notice declaring the Fishery in which the boat is authorized to be used.
 - (2) licensed professional fishermen using a licensed fishing boat the licence for which is endorsed to permit the boat to be used to take fish by means of a trawl net and the boat is being used in accordance with that endorsement.

Revocation

6. The following notices are cancelled-

- (3) All the waters of the Indian Ocean bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of 31°43'27" south latitude and the highwater mark on the mainland of Western Australia; thence due west along 31°43'27" south latitude to where it intersects with the 200 metre isobath; thence generally in a northwesterly direction along the 200 metre isobath to its intersection with 29°03' south latitude; thence due east along 29°03' south latitude to where it intersects with the high water mark on the mainland of Western Australia thence generally southeasterly along the high water mark to the commencement point.

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- (4) All the waters of the Indian Ocean bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of 27°51' south latitude and the high water mark on the mainland of Western Australia; thence west along 27°51' south latitude to where it intersects with the 200 metre isobath; thence generally southeasterly along the 200 metre isobath to where it intersects with 29°03' south latitude; thence east along latitude 29°03' south to where it intersects with the high water mark on the mainland of Western Australia; thence generally northwesterly and northerly along the high water mark to the commencement point.
- (5) All waters of the Indian Ocean on the landward side of the 200 metre isobath between 27°51' south latitude and 26°30' south latitude.
- (6) All the waters of the Indian Ocean and Shark Bay on the landward side of the 200 metre isobath between 26°30' south latitude and 23°34' south latitude (near Amherst Point) together with those waters of Shark Bay south of 26°30' south latitude.
- (7) All the waters of the Indian Ocean off the north west coast of Western Australia on
